

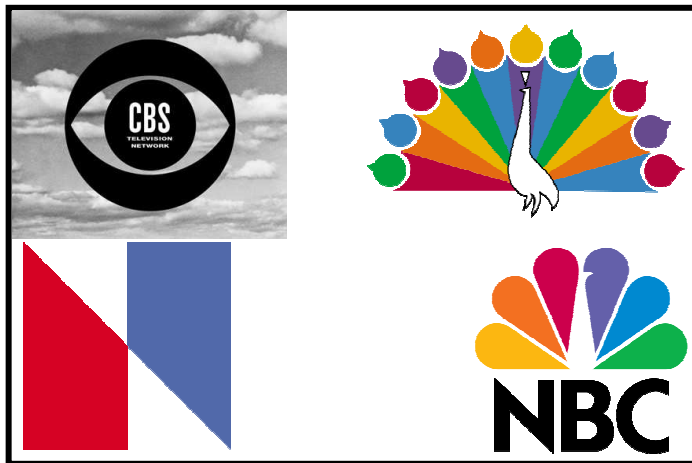

Why does the television station CBS have the “eye” logo and NBC the “peacock” logo? CBS originally started out in 1927 as a radio network called the Columbia Broadcasting System. In the 1940’s they started broadcasting on television, but did not get their “eye” logo until October 1951.



Before that they used a spotlight on the letters CBS. The first picture is an early version of the CBS eye logo. Some variation of the “eye” logo has always been used by CBS since then. In the early years CBS rarely broadcast in color as the technology that was licensed to do so belonged to NBC’s parent company RCA. They did broadcast some specials, such as “The Wizard of OZ” and Roger and Hammerstein’s “Cinderella” in color. It wasn’t until the fall of 1967 that CBS broadcast mostly in color. CBS had many popular shows both as a radio network and a television station. My siblings and I used to watch “Captain Kangaroo”, a popular children’s program that aired live from 1955-1984. And, of course, we watched “The Wizard of OZ” whenever it aired. Many of you may remember “I Love Lucy”, which started out as a radio program called “My Favorite Husband”. CBS was very good at recognizing and keeping talented people. The other logos are those of NBC. The upper right logo is the original peacock logo of NBC. This was introduced in 1956. The reason it was introduced was because many more programs were in color. Also, NBC’s parent company, RCA, manufactured color TVs and it was used as a marketing tool, in the hopes that more people would buy color TVs. From 1976 to 1979 the peacock was replaced by the colored “N” in the lower left corner. A revised peacock with only six feathers was introduced in 1979. A further revision in 1986 gave us the peacock we see today, the final picture. ABC was a spinoff from NBC and used to run the serial “The Lone Ranger” on Saturdays, while NBC ran “Hopalong Cassidy”, another western I used to watch as a child.
