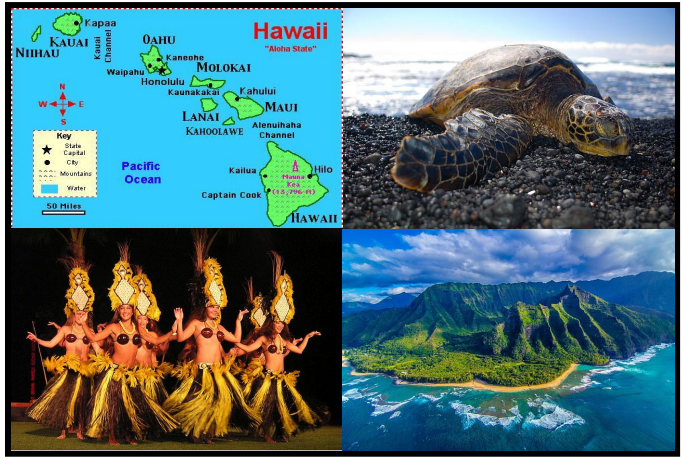

Don't forget to put your clocks forward one hour tonight. Tomorrow is the beginning of Daylight Saving time this year. A lot of cool things have happened on March 12th. In 1894, Coca-Cola started selling their first bottles in Vicksburg, Mississippi. In 1912, Juliette

Gordon Low founded the Girl Scouts in the United States. But these happened before our time. Many of us were around when, in 1959, Congress approved admitting Hawaii as our 50th state. And what a jewel it is. The state of Hawaii consists of eight larger islands and many small islands in the Pacific Ocean, about 2000 miles southwest of the continental United States. Seven of those larger islands have permanent populations. The biggest and youngest island is the island of Hawaii (often called the big island to avoid confusion with the name of the state). About 1500 to 1700 years ago the first people visited the islands. They were Polynesians and came to the islands after traveling great distances in canoes. By the time that Europeans discovered the islands in 1778, the islands were ruled by chieftains. I have visited 3 of the islands, Kauai, Oahu and the big island. This summer we will visit Maui. The Hawaiian Islands are a favorite vacation spot. The weather is usually quite nice and the scenery is spectacular. There are active volcanoes on the big island. The weather is ideal for growing things. Sugar cane and pineapples are Hawaii's main cash crops. Kona coffee is a very expensive coffee that is grown on the big island. Hawaii is also famous for macadamia nuts and flowers. We have taken tours of apple farms and visited the Dole pineapple plantation. There are lovely beaches to go to on the islands. Punaluu is a black beach sand that is often visited by green sea turtles. We have close up pictures of the turtles, which are quite large, but visitors are not supposed to get too close. The native Hawaiians are famous for their hula dances and for luaus, a Hawaiian feast that is usually accompanied by hula dancers. There is much scenery to see and large national parks. It is a great place to visit. As the Hawaiians say, 'Aloha': the word used to say both hi and good-bye. You crown the year with your bounty, and your carts overflow with abundance. Psalm 65:11
