It's spring again. It's that time of year when everything is growing. It is also time for Easter (next weekend). KaiTsu is going to learn a new way to dye Easter eggs. You know about that, right? Besides the celebration of the risen Christ, Easter is also a celebration of spring. In that vein, there is an imaginary being (sort of like Santa Claus) that brings brightly colored eggs and candies to good little boys and girls on Easter morning. He is called the Easter Bunny. It is believed that German immigrants to America brought over their tradition of an egg laying hare (rabbit) in the 1700's. Their children would make nests for the rabbit to lay brightly colored eggs in. The children would come back on Easter morning to collect the eggs. This tradition soon spread throughout the United States. In more recent times we have added candy and chocolate eggs to the bounty that children can expect on Easter morning. They can also have a lot of fun coloring the eggs. Only color **BOILED EGGS!** Many times there is a fun time of having what is called an Easter egg hunt. The parents or some other adults will hide brightly colored Easter eggs in the back yard or at a school or park and the children will go out with baskets to gather the eggs. It is great fun. But, if you forget to boil the eggs there can be two problems. One is that the children may drop the eggs or accidentally break the eggs and make a mess. Two is that if not all the eggs are found, there may be raw eggs that will spoil in the back yard. When a spoiled egg is broken it is **VERY** smelly. Egg coloring kits are sold in all the department stores (Walmart, Target, etc). If you have never colored eggs, you should try it. It is possible to get quite creative in coloring eggs. The use of crayons to draw on the eggs will leave areas where the dye does not color. By dunking an egg only half way into a dye, you can color only part of the egg, and then put the other part into another dye. By coloring with first one dye and then another, you can make new colors. By varying the time (longer or shorter) that an egg is in a dye, you can get different shades of a color. Anyway, if you do it, have fun!
