Some of the R&B songs that you may have heard are "Respect" by Aretha Franklin, "I Heard It Through The Grapevine" by Marvin Gaye, and "(Sittin' On) The Dock Of The Bay" by Otis Redding. One Performer of contemporary R&B was Michael.
