What do you think? On May 15, 1869, the National Woman Suffrage Association (NWSA) was formed by Susan B. Anthony and Elizabeth



Cady Stanton. The NWSA was an organization made up primarily of women. The goal of the NWSA was to secure an amendment to the Constitution of the United States in favor of women's suffrage. What does that mean? In those times it was not legal for a woman to vote or hold public office in most of the United States. A very few women in some areas were permitted to vote, but they had to meet certain qualifications. Women's suffrage would guarantee all women the right to vote without restrictions. This was just after the civil war and there was a great push for an amendment to allow male Negroes the right to vote. The NWSA thought that they might be able to piggyback their cause onto the same amendment, eliminating both race and gender as barriers to the right to vote, so they opposed the amendment unless it included gender. However, the NWSA suffered bad publicity as a result of their "opposition" to the race amendment. The 15<sup>th</sup> amendment eliminates race as a qualifier for the right to vote. The NWSA worked hard for many years and underwent name changes and organizational changes. Fifty years after NWSA was formed, at the end of the Great War (what we now call World War 1), the 19<sup>th</sup> amendment to the Constitution was passed. It states: "The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex. Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate legislation." It was ratified in August of 1920 (an amendment must be passed by 75% of the States). Today, we take it for granted that women can vote, but it was not always the case.
