Please remember to send me or tell Jack or Milan your ideas for newsletter topics. On October 9th KaiTsu and Charles took a trip to the Flume Gorge in New Hampshire. It is run and maintained by New Hampshire Parks and Recreation.

The fee is \$15 per adult. The Flume is a natural gorge (gorge: a deep narrow passage with rocky sides) that extends about 800 feet at the base of Mount Liberty.

The gorge has walls of Conway granite that rise to a height of 70 to 90 feet above the water and the walls are 12 to 20 feet apart. So it is very narrow. The Flume was discovered in 1808 by 93 year old "Aunt" Jess Guernsey when she was fishing. She had trouble convincing her family of how marvelous it was, but eventually she persuaded others to come and see for themselves. At the time there was a huge egg shaped boulder suspended between the walls, but it was washed away in a rainstorm in 1883. The boulder was never found. The gorge now has a wooden walkway all the way up to the top. The hike starts at the visitor center and is along a two mile loop that lets you experience the falls and other beautiful sights. You are warned that the hike includes uphill walking and lots of stairs. But it is worth it. On the way we passed a covered bridge that was built in 1886 across the Pemigewasset river. Pemigewasset means "swift or rapid current" in the Abenaki Indian language. Then we got to the wooden walkway. You can see that there were a lot of people going up the gorge. The person in the foreground of the bottom left picture is KaiTsu. At the top of the walkway is Avalanche Falls. The bottom right picture is an old (1939) covered walking bridge that we went over. All of these covered bridges have been rebuilt many times, so they are entirely safe. On the way back, KaiTsu and I decided to try the "Wolf's Den" (not required) which was a narrow path/tunnel we had to crawl through. We made it! I will try to post some pictures on our site.
